1. **QUESTIONS:** Please answer **ALL** of the following questions in a concise manner, using no more than two (2) typed, double-spaced pages (total).

- 1) Describe your activities and interests during high school (ASB, music, sports, clubs, work, etc.).
- 2) Describe how your strengths have prepared you to make responsible choices as a contributing member of the global community.
- 3) Share your ideas regarding the impact further education may have on your life.

2. **ESSAY:** Please respond to **ONE** of the following essay prompts. Limit your response to two (2) typed, double-spaced pages.

1) Suppose you had the opportunity to spend the day with *anyone*. With whom would it be and how would you spend your time? How would spending time with this person affect you?

2) Describe who it is you want to be on the day you graduate from college, university, or vocational school. Include the goals and aspirations you have now as a high school senior and how your secondary education will have helped you reach your goals.
