

Graduation and Baccalaureate 2018

Information Sheet & Application

Graduation is approaching! There are several ways to get involved in the ceremony or in Baccalaureate.

We need:

- An art piece for the cover of Graduation and Baccalaureate programs (image should be related to wolves, Eastlake, WSPS, or Graduation and must be in pen or pencil)
- Students artwork to display at Baccalaureate
- Performers for graduation (one student speaker, one student performance, one national anthem performer)
- Performers for Baccalaureate (musicians, poetry, dancers, speakers, etc.)

Things you need to know:

- All performances and speeches must be appropriate for school and graduation. All speeches, lyrics, poems, etc. must have a written copy turned in with the application (or by April 13th at the latest).
- Speakers: your speech should be about 5-7 minutes (no longer than 10).
- Performers: your performance should be a maximum of 5 minutes. You don't have to perform on your own either; you can have a duet or group performance as well.
- Don't be afraid to be **diverse!** We are looking for diversity of thought, action and of course, culture.

April 16th and 17th	Check your audition time outside Ms. Hilgesen's room (E104)
April 18th	<p>Auditions at 1:30pm In the Choir room for both graduation and Baccalaureate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will be auditioning in front of senior class advisors, senior class officers, and PTSA representatives. Please be completely prepared to audition! If you are not prepared, you will not be selected.
June 16th	Baccalaureate – 9:30am (Seniors arrive by 8:45am) – Timberlake Church
June 18th	<p>Graduation – 8pm – Key Arena (Seniors arrive by 7pm)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Selected speakers/performers will need to arrive earlier (time is TBD) for a sound check.
