- 2) Describe how your learnings have prepared you to make responsible choices as a contributing member of the global community.
- 3) Write your ideas regarding the impact further education may have on your life.

2. **ESSAY:** Please respond to **ONE** of the following essay prompts. Limit your response to two (2) typed, double-spaced pages.

- 1) Suppose you had the opportunity to spend the day with *anyone*. With whom would it be and how would you spend your time? How would spending time with this person affect you?

- 2) Tell who it is you want to be on the day you graduate from college, university, or vocational school. Include the goals and aspirations you have now as a high school senior and how your secondary education will help you reach your goals.
