This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a former student of Inglewood Middle School for the education (college or vocational/technical school) of the chosen recipient and may only be used to pay for tuition, required textbooks, or room and board for on-campus housing.

The Scholarship Committee will award this scholarship based on the following criteria:

- 1. Extra-curricular and community service activities
- 2. Character references
- 3. Essay response
- 4. Academic diligence and motivation. The applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

Instructions to the Applicant:

The following information must be submitted in the specified order and stapled together:

- 1. A properly completed application; typewritten or printed legibly
 - a. Questionnaire
 - b. Extra-curricular and community activities (Grades 9th 12th) & previous and current Inglewood involvement
 - c. Essay Response
- 2. Two letters of character reference.
 - a. One should be from a faculty member at your high school such as a teacher, counselor, or administrator. The other could be from an employer, family friend, or other appropriate individual. Letters from your immediate family will not be accepted.
 - b. We will already have a list of your activities and accomplishments from the application. In this section we are looking for information from the author regarding your work ethic, attitude, commitment, ambition, etc.
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript including the first semester of your senior year.
