These full-length practice tests offer students the opportunity to practice test taking strategies and determine baseline scores prior to taking the official SAT and ACT college entrance exams. Both the SAT and ACT tests are widely used by U.S. colleges to determine admissions and award scholarships. Because the SAT and the ACT test different subjects and score differently, students may perform better on one than on the other.
